Please read the following requirements and conditions of becoming a New Referee for (CUSC).

There will be a charge of \$110 (MINI REFEREE) or \$135 (CSA ENTRY LEVEL) Referee Course which covers: \$50 for complete referee supplies consisting of:

- shirt, shorts and socks, set of assistant referee flags whistle with lanyard, Red/yellow card set and game report sheets
- \$60 MINI REFEREE for course registration (non-refundable in the event of cancellation for any reason)
- OR
- \$85 CSA ENTRY LEVEL for course registration (non-refundable in the event of cancellation for any reason)

If you are chosen, a cheque in the amount of \$110 (MINI) or \$135 (CSA ENTRY LEVEL) will be required to secure your spot on the course. Until your cheque is received, your spot is not guaranteed. Dates will be set for you to come to the club office and obtain your referee uniform and kit. NOTE: Preference will be given to players, parents, and residents in the CUSC area.

Your Referee course will be held at a local Orleans school and/or community center (*to be advised later*) **You must come wearing your complete referee uniform and bring with you all other supplies.**

The **CSA Entry Level course** will be held during a two-day period on April 28 & 29, 2018 and you must attend both consecutive days to complete the course. A pre-course workbook will be handed out prior to the course and you must complete this to attend the course. Failure to complete the pre-course workbook will disqualify you from attending the course. No refunds will be given caused by non-completion of workbook. Candidates who pass the written exam will receive their CSA badge and license directly from the OSA. Those candidates who do not pass the written exam may request one re-write of the exam. Failure to pass this second attempt will result in you being ineligible to referee this season.

The **MINI Referee course** will be a one-day course on May 13, 2018. Candidates who pass the written exam will receive an OSA license allowing them to officiate recreational-house league games for one year. Those candidates who do not pass the written exam may request one re-write of the exam. Failure to pass this second attempt will result in you being ineligible to referee this season. Please ensure to bring a lunch on course days as we will be stopping only for a 1/2-hour lunch. (*Please arrive 10 minutes before the start time*)

For MINI Referees, most of your assignments will be on Friday and Sunday evenings during the summer season which starts in late May.

You must have access to the internet to retrieve your assignments and must complete all assignment reporting within 12 hours of completion. You will need a **personal** email address, so you can receive correspondence from the Club and you (**not your parents**) are responsible to accept or reject assignments. **CUSC is hiring you and not your parents, so I (Head Referee) expect to be contacted only by you when required.**
