## YOUTH and VIDEO COACH

**Ottawa TFC\*** (CUSC operating as Ottawa TFC), a not for profit corporation registered in the province of Ontario is looking for qualified candidates to fill the temporary position of Youth and Video coach services.

**Duration of role:** This Contractual Service Agreement shall be for the period covering May 20, 2019 to July 21st, 2019. An average of 35-40 hours per week will be worked during this period.

### Youth Coaching Responsibilities/Requirements:

- Be available for the on-field execution and coordination of youth programs at the recreational, competitive and academy levels, which run primarily between 4:00 pm and 8:30 pm on weeknights, Saturday mornings (between 8 and noon) and Sunday evenings (between 4 and 8pm)
- **Coach Training:** Learn to Train or Soccer for life coaching license is required.
  - An Ontario C-license is preferred.
- **Leadership Skills:** Able to lead/assist staff in leading large groups of kids through quality training program
- **Communications skills:** able to communicate confidently and clearly with parents and other volunteers.

### Video Responsibilities: Requirements:

- Be available during evenings and weekends to setup video equipment at Millennium Park, and arrange for games and/or training to be recorded.
  - The schedule of what should be recorded will be established by the club head coach
  - Other staff may assist with the actual filming, but the Youth and Video coach will be responsible for setup, take down and processing of film.
- Within 24 hours, download all games to club's google drive and communicate with staff once this is done.
- Maintain and manage equipment on a daily basis.
- Soccer knowledge combined with Video editing skills preferred.
  - Someone who can edit videos and create highlight videos, or other promotional materials will be preferred.

### GPS and Testing:

- Work with GPS system used to track player training and games. This involves:
  - Maintaining and managing 16 GPS units that will be used daily with a different team to track their training/games.
  - Cleaning and maintaining the GPS "bras" daily
  - Charging the GPS and checking functionality daily while uploading data daily.
  - Processing and managing GPS data daily.
  - Producing reports for staff coaches daily.
- Working with the testing equipment for speed, agility and dribbling testing with designated Academy and competitive teams. This involves:
  - Involves actually conducting the tests according to strict testing protocols
  - Maintaining, charging and cleaning equipment between tests.
  - Processing data and producing reports for staff coaches and players as required.

### Compensation:

Depending on experience and certification level, \$15-\$18 per hour for the provision of services specified herein.
